Students are required to take the medical checkup on one of the following days listed below. Make sure you are up-to-date on the annual medical checkup to review any medical conditions and lifestyle habits.

Please be sure to make a web reservation and answer the questionnaire on Tokyo Tech Portal Website before taking the medical checkup.

Please bring "student ID card" and "urine sample"

- Eligible Persons : Bachelor's degree students (excluding newly enrolled students)  
Master's and doctoral degree students, Other students Excluding the following: ( 1. Non-degree students  
2. Special auditing students 3. Tokubetsu Kenkyu Gakusei)
- Medical certificate: Take it on April(in Ookayama) results will be available from the end of May 2019.  
Take it on May(in Suzukakedai) results will be available from the beginning of June 2019.
- If you do not take the medical checkup, you will not be able to receive your medical certificate.  
(Please note that you may be asked to submit a copy of your health certificate when applying for a scholarship, dormitory, job, etc.)

### Medical checkup includes:

- ① Urine Test ②Measurements: height, weight ③Eye sight ④Blood Pressure Test ⑤Blood Test (M1/D1 only)  
⑥Chest X-ray Examination ⑦Medical questionnaire by Nurse ⑧Doctor's Consultation (selected /if requested)  
⑨Counseling( if requested)

\*If you do not take the chest x-ray examination, you will not be able to receive your medical certificate from the automatic certificate machine. Please come to the Health Support Center if you need a copy of your medical certificate.
